ASRL, which has been the world leader in industrial sulphur research for the past 44 years, is affiliated with the Department of Chemistry at the University of Calgary.

The ASRL Chair in Industrial Sulfur Chemistry will develop a research program in industrial sulfur chemistry to contribute fundamental knowledge for future developments in oil and gas production, sulfur chemistry and the manufacture of petrochemicals in Alberta.

The Chair will join with ASRL in examining sour gas applications, and uses for sulphur as a byproduct of other processes (e.g. upgrading), sulphur storage, properties of sulphur in the reservoir, flue gas desulfurization, etc.
